# NOTE SUL PRESENT SIMPLE ALLA TERZA PERSONA SINGOLARE

- Alla terza persona singolare, i verbi terminano sempre in -s: he wants, she needs, he gives, she thinks.
- Le forme negative e interrogative usano il DOES (= la terza persona singolare dell'ausiliare 'DO') + il verbo alla forma base.

He wants ice cream. Does he want strawberry? He does not want vanilla.

• I verbi che terminano in -y: alla terza persona la -y diventa -ies:

fly --> flies, cry --> cries

Eccezione: in caso di vocale prima della -y:

play --> plays, pray --> prays

Aggiungere -es ai verbi che terminano in:-ss, -x, -sh, -ch: he passes, she catches, he fixes, it pushes
